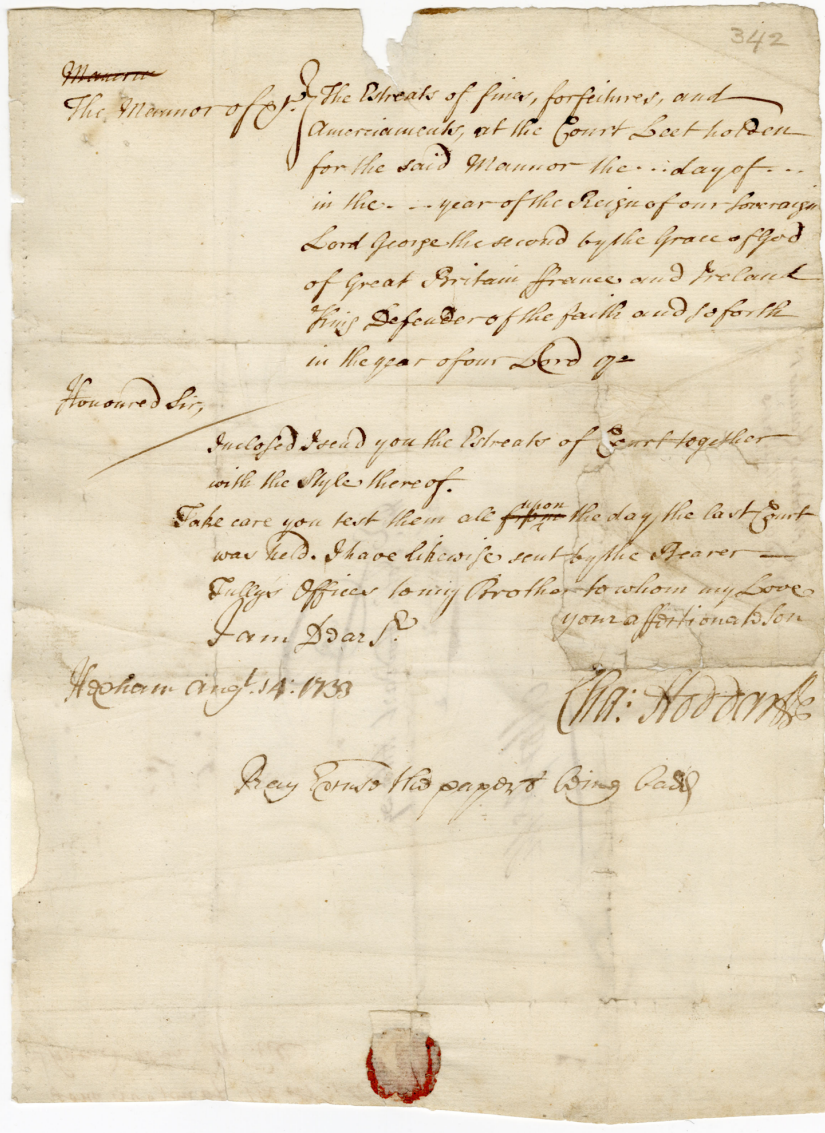

Lord George the second by the Grace of God
of Great Britain France and Ireland
King Defender of the faith and so forth
in the year of our Lord 172

Inclosed I send you the Estreats of Court together
with the Style thereof.

Take care you test them all ~~from~~ upon the day the last Court
was held. I have likewise sent by the Bearer ---
Tullys Officer to my Brother to whom my Love
I am Dear S[ir]
