Ownership	<p>Norham Castle manor belonged to the see of Durham from pre conquest times and remained so until 1844 when it was transferred to the jurisdiction of Northumberland. It and its tithes were leased to various families over time. It did seem to operate as a separate manor from Norham, the court rolls held in NRO 00558 would support this opinion.</p> <p>In 1921 the principal landowners were the Trustees of Lady Jerningham, Col Sir Francis D. Blake, C.B. Capt. James Rea and Lieutenant Col. William Ord 1921, p.435).</p>
