Ownership	<p>Norham manor belonged to the see of Durham from pre conquest times and remained so until 1844 when it was transferred to the jurisdiction of Northumberland. It and its tithes were leased to various families over time. In 1560 Sir Thomas Haggerston is recorded as lord of the manor of Norham.</p> <p>In 1921 the principal landowners were the Trustees of Lady Jerningham, Col Sir Francis D. Blake, C.B. Capt. James Rea and Lieutenant Col. William Ord 1921, p.435</p>
