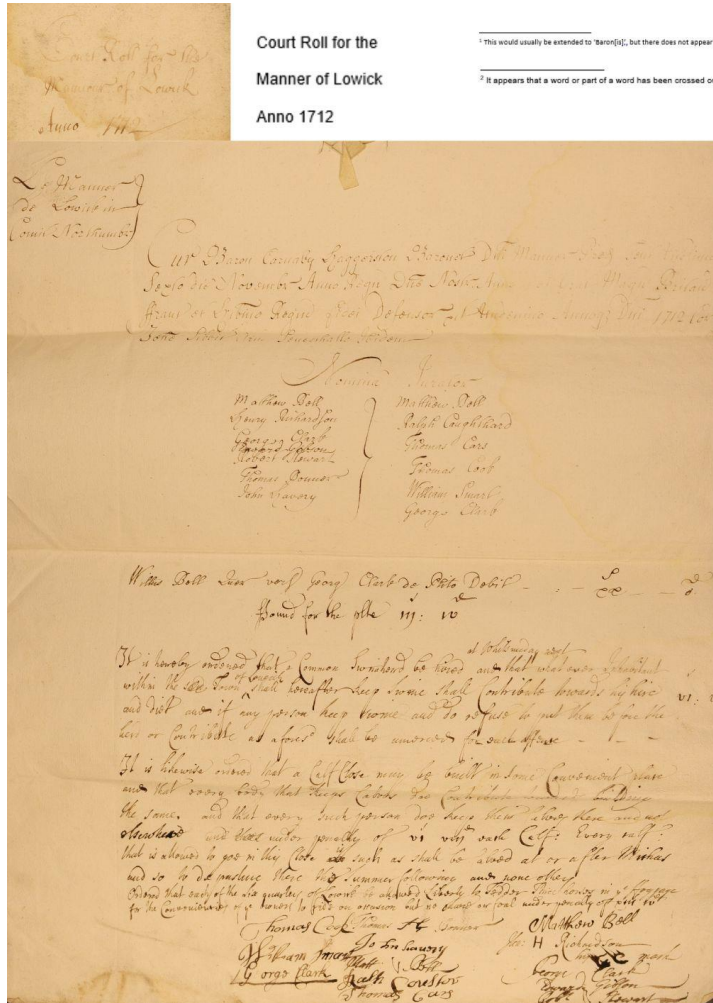

It is hereby ordered that a Common Swineherd be hired and that what ever inhabitant
of Lowick
within the ~~xxx~~ Town ^a shall hereafter keep Swine shall Contribute towards his hire
and diet and if any person keep swine and do refuse to put them before the
herd or Contribute as afores[aid] shall be amerced for each offence --- ---

It is likewise ordered that a Calf Close may be built in ~~some~~ Convenient place
and that every body that keeps Calves doe Contribute towards building
the same, and that every such person doe keep their Calves there and not
elsewhere and that under penalty of vj s viij d each Calf. Every calf
that is allowed to goe in this Close ~~xxx~~ such as shall be Calved at or after Mich[aelmas]
and so to de pasture these the Summer following and none others
Ordered that each of the Six quarters of Lowick be allowed Liberty to Tedder Three horses in the Foggage

for the Conveniences of the owners to ride on occasion but no mare or foal under penalty of xij s iv d
