Notice of intent to surrender property at Acomb Common, Joseph Hutchinson, 24  
October 1808.

I do hereby give you Notice that at the next Court to be held for the Manor of Hexham I propose to surrender in Court One undivided Moiety or full half part of all that Piece or Parcel of Land with the Appurtenances lying on Acomb Common and which upon the Division of the said Common was set out and allotted to Robert Salmon of Hexham Gentleman containing five Acres two Roods and eleven Perches more or less, by its right Metes and Bounds not upon a Sale thereof but to and for the Uses of my Will to be executed in the presence of three or more credible Witnesses - As Witness my Hand this twentyfourth Day of October One thousand eight hundred and eight. : Joseph Hutchinson
