We John Bell of Hexham Spirit Merchant Attorney for William Armstrong of Wapping Ship Chandler, lawfully authorised and Robert Scott of Willymontswicke Miller and Nicholas Armstrong of Newcastle upon Tyne Yeoman do hereby give you Notice that at the Court to be holden for the Manor of Hexham this Day we propose to surrender in Court certain Hereditaments in Acomb to which the said William Armstrong is this Day to be admitted as Heir of his late Father, by such Descriptions as shall be deemed necessary to pass the same To the Use and Behoof of Robert Purvis of High Heskett in the County of Cumberland Gentleman his Heirs and Assigns Not upon a Sale of the said Hereditaments and Premises But by way of Mortgage for securing to the said Robert Purvis the Repayment of the Sum of Fifty Pounds and Interest according to the Proviso contained in the Letter of Attorney from the said William Armstrong, Dated the Twentififth Day of April 1809:
