## Notice of intent to surrender property at Acomb, William, Ann & John Carr to Anthony Hutchinson, 25 May 1809.

We do hereby give you Notice that at the Court to be holden for the Manor of Hexham this Day we propose to surrender in Court One undivided Moity or full Half Part of One Messuage with a Curtilage to the same belonging situate standing and being in the Town of Acomb and Thirteen Acres of Ground more or less lying and being in Longish Field there, ~~now in~~ bounding on Lands of Jno<sup>1</sup> Errington Esquire on the North the Hedge of Acomb West Field on the West Lands now or late John Armstrongs on the East and Lands late in Possession of Margaret Lambert and now belonging to Simon Newburn on the South of the apportioned yearly Rent of Two Shillings and Sixpence And also one undivided Moity or full Half Part of All that Plot or Parcel of Land with the Appurtenances late Part of Acomb Common which was set out and allotted to Thomas Nicholson upon the Division of the said Common, containing in the whole Nine Acres one Rood and twenty six Perches more or less To the Use and Behoof of <sup>Anthony</sup> Michael Hutchinson of Matten Low Hall Husbandman his Heirs and Assigns, ~~not upon a~~ Sale, but by Way of Mortgage for securing the Repaym<sup>en</sup>t of the Sum of Four Hundred Pounds with Interest for the same. Dated this Twenty fifth Day of May in the Year of our Lord 1809.
