Notice of intent to surrender property at Acomb, John Taylor to Edward Charlton, 25 May 1809.

Taylor to Edw[ar]d Charlton

I do hereby give you Notice that at the Court to be holden for the Manor of Hexham this Day I propose to surrender in Court All that Piece or Parcel of Land late Part of Acomb Common which upon the Division thereof was set out and allotted to John Daglease of Acomb Shovelmaker in respect of his Copyhold Estate in Acomb containing One Acre three Roods and twenty eight perches more or less And all that other Piece or Parcel of Land late Part of Acomb Common aforesaid which was set out and allotted to Thomas Daglias in respect of his Copyhold Estate in Acomb upon the said Division containing One Acre three Roods and twentythree Perches more or less To the Use and Behoof of Edward Charlton of Acomb aforesaid Plasterer and his Assigns for and during the Term of his natural Life without Impeachment of or for any Manner of Waste so far as the Nature and Tenure of the said Premises will admit with Remainder to the Uses of his Will to be executed in the Presence of three Witnesses Remainder to his Heirs and Assigns Upon a Sale of the said Premises made by me to him in consideration of Two hundred pounds Purchase Money agreed to be paid by him to me for the same.
