Honour/Lordship	Barony of Bolam
Ownership	Trewick was a township within the barony of Bolam, and was owned by the Trewick family (Hodgson, 1827, p.364). Bolam and Trewyke were assessed as one township in 1382 (Hodgson, 1827, p.331). The Bekering family conveyed their lands here with Harnham to John de Strivelyn, and part of it was later owned by The Loraine family of Kirkharle. The Middleton family owned Trewick from 1663, and it was passed down to their heir Sir Charles Monck in Hodgson's time (Hodgson, 1827, p.365). It is not a manor in its own right.
