## Draft court roll, Manor of Bamburgh Castle, Northumberland, 25 October 1836.

All that farmstead on the north side of Sunderland  
in the County of North<sup>d</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> Bounded by the  
Back lane on the north, on the Town Street on the south  
and on freehold premises belongi<sup>g</sup> to Lord Crewe's Trees  
on the east & West, And also all those four  
cottages and a granary above the same also  
on the north side of Sunderland in the County  
of North<sup>d</sup> aforesaid and then occupied by  
Thomas Eadington and others - bounded by  
copyhold premises belongi<sup>g</sup> to Frances Wake  
on the East on freehold premises belongi<sup>g</sup> to  
The s<sup>d</sup> Trustees on the West, on the back lane  
on the north, and on the Town Street on the  
South - And also all that ~~small~~ small field  
or parcel of ground, situate near the West End  
of Sunderland in the County of North<sup>d</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> &  
containi<sup>g</sup> by estimation three roods or thereabouts  
together with the steam Corn Mill erected thereon  
And also all those lands on the south side  
of Sunderland in the Co<sup>untly</sup> of North<sup>d</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> called  
Sandford Lowfield, Bought Hill, Rashes, Souses  
and Sally Bottom which were all bounded  
by copyhold lands belongi<sup>g</sup> to the heirs of Henry  
Johnson on the south by copyhold lands belongi<sup>g</sup>  
to the s<sup>d</sup> John Johnson & John Railston on the  
north by the Common Lane for the use of the  
Copyholders on the West, and by the Twin  
Crumbles belongi<sup>g</sup> to the s<sup>d</sup> Trustees, and by  
copyhold lands of Rachael Skelly, on the East.  
And also all that Close called the Moor  
Close bounded by copyhold lands of the s<sup>d</sup> John  
Railston on the south and by the Common  
lane on the north East & West. And also  
all other the customary or copyhold lands  
situate in the Township of Sunderland, within  
the same Manor of or to which the said William  
Anderson was seized or entitled at Law  
or Equity.

All that farmstead on the north side of Sunderland

the Sally Bottom which were all bounded  
by copyhold lands belonging to the heirs of Henry  
Johnson on the south by copyhold lands belonging  
to the s[ai]d John Johnson & John Railston on the  
north by the Common Lane for the use of the  
Copyholders on the West, and by the Twin  
Crumbles belonging to the s[ai]d Trustees, and by  
copyhold lands of Rachael Skelly on the East.  
And also all that Close called the Moor  
Close bounded by copyhold lands of the s[ai]d John  
Railston on the south and by the Common  
lane on the north East & West. And also  
all other the customary or copy hold lands  
situate in the Township of Sunderland, within  
the same Manor of or to which the said William  
Anderson was seized or entitled at law  
or Equity.
