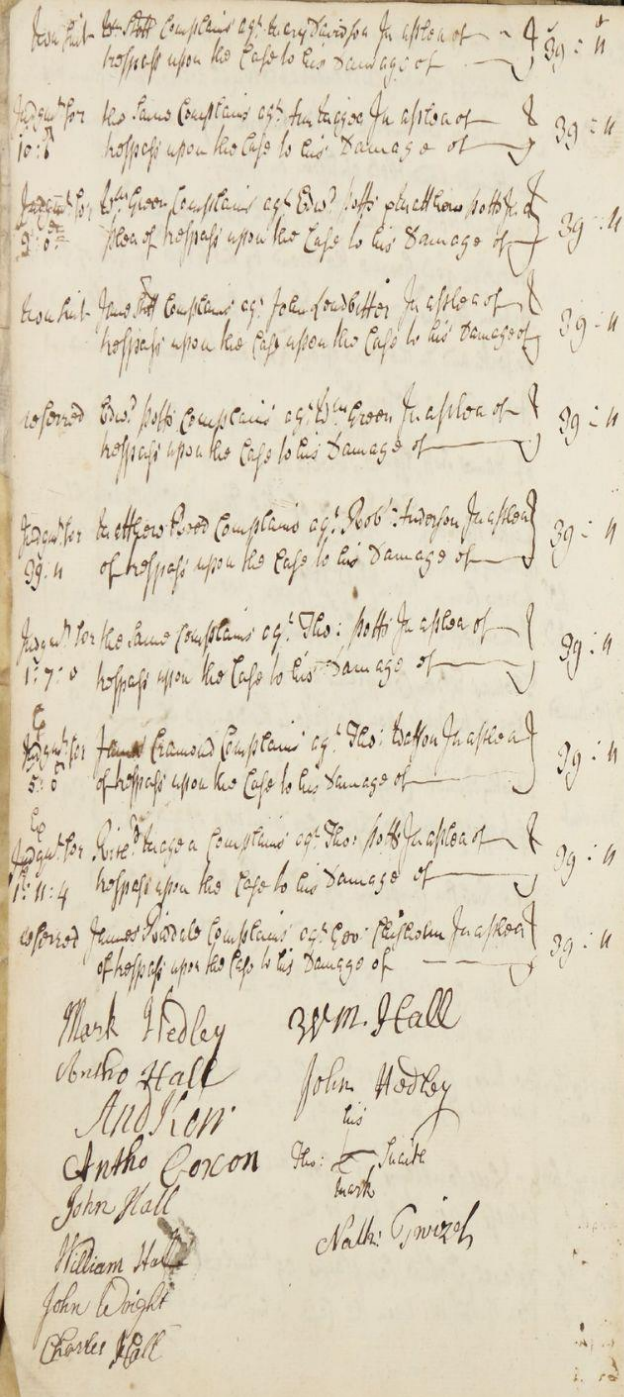

² Only cases to a value of less than 40 shillings (£2) could be heard at a manorial court. Those with a greater value had to be referred upwards. Therefore any request for fines or damages would be for just under that, 39 shillings 11 pence (just over £1.99 1/2p)
