| <b>Ownership</b>                               | Alnham was held by the family of de Vesci from the time of the Conquest and remained with the de Vesci family until 1309 when Bishop Bek sold the Barony of Alnwick to Henry de Percy. From that time onwards Alnham has followed the same descent as the other Percy estates.   |
| <b>Courts</b>                                  | Manor court rolls are held at Alnwick Castle for 1475.   |
