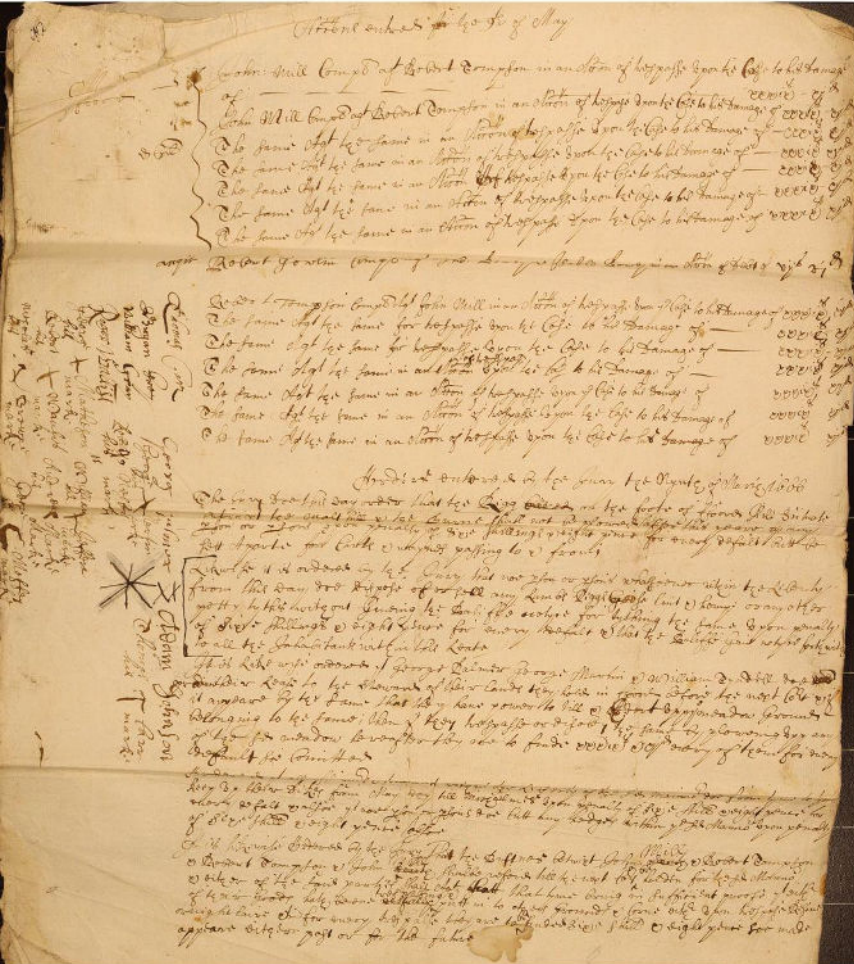

Orders entered by the Jury the Nynth of March 1669  
The Jury Doe this day order that the Rigg fields on the foots of Ford Hill Situate between the Mill hill & the Bame shall not be plowed after this yeare by any p[er]son or p[er]sons upon penalty of Sixe Shillings & eight pence for every default but be sett Apart for Cartes & waynes passing to & from

Likewise it is ordered by the Jury that noe p[er]son or p[er]sons whatsoever within the Liberty from this day doe dispose of or sell any Lambs Piggs Geese Lint & hempes or any other petty tythes without giving the Bailiffs notice for tything the same upon penalty of Sixe Shillings & eight pence for every default & that the Bailiffs Give notice forthwith to all the Inhabitant[es] within the Lease

It is Likewise ordered that George Palmer George Martin & William Tyndel doe [...] their Lease to the Steward of their lands they hold in Ford before the next Court & if it appears by the same that they have power to till & Evert upp the meadow Grounds belonging to the same; then if they trespass or disobey the same by plowing any part of the s[ai]d meadow hereafter they are to finde xxxix s x j d every of them for every default soe Committed

Ordered that all Farm[er]s & tenants within the Liberty of the s[ai]d Man[or] doe from tyme to tyme keep up their Dikes from May Day till Michelmas upon penalty of Sixe Shillings & eight pence for every default & alsoe that noe p[er]son or p[er]sons doe cut any hedges within the s[ai]d Man[or] upon penalty of sixe shillings & eight pence alsoe

It is Likewise Ordered by the Jury That the Business betwixt John Smith-Mill & Robert Tompson & Robert Tompson & John Smith-Mill shall be referred till the next Court to be holden for the s[ai]d Man[or] & either of the said parties shall Ag[ree] to that tyme bring in sufficient proofs that either of their Goods hath bene wrongfully trespassing & putt in to other Grounds & Come with[er] upon trespass: Resine or night lare etc. for every trespass they are to finde Indeed Sixe shillings & eight pence soe made appear & either past or for the future
