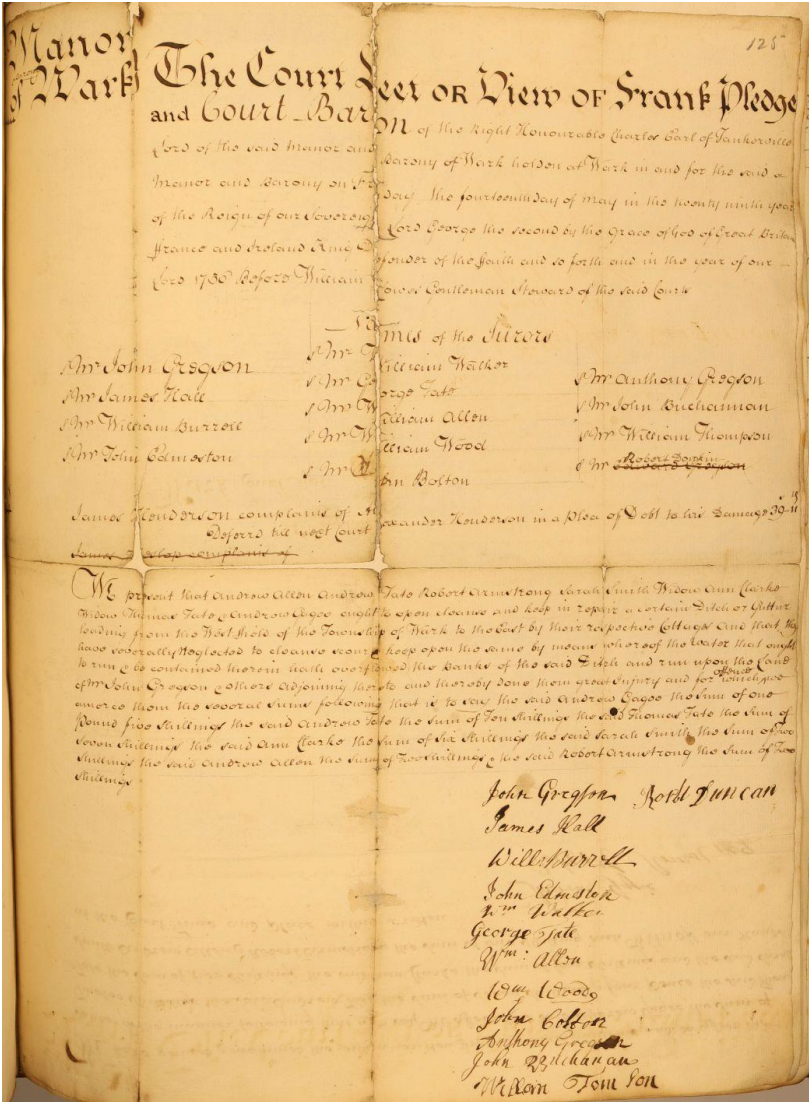

We present that Andrew Allen Andrew Tate Robert Armstrong Sarah Smith Widow Ann Clarke Widow Thomas Tate & Andrew Gagee ought to open cleanse and keep in repair a certain Ditch or Gutter leading from the West Field of the Township of Wark to the East by their respective Cottages and that they have severally neglected to cleanse scour & keep open the same by means whereof the water that ought to run & be contained therein hath overflowed the banks of the said Ditch and run upon the Land of M[aste]r John Gregson & others adjoining thereto and thereby done them great Injury and for which /offence\ we amerce them the several sums following that is to say the said Andrew Gagee the Sum of one Pound five shillings the said Andrew Tate the sum of Ten shillings the said Thomas Tate the Sum of Seven Shillings the said Ann Clarke the Sum of Six Shillings the said Sarah Smith the Sum of Two Shillings the said Andrew Allen the Sum of Two Shillings & the said Robert Armstrong the Sum of Two Shillings
